

# District 10 Portable Challenge Equipment Check Out

## Check Out Guidelines:

- \* Portable Challenge Equipment may be checked out by agents who have been through the training.
- \* Equipment can be picked up at the District Office or coordinated with another County who has equipment checked out.
- \* Equipment will not be shipped in any case. It is the responsibility of the party checking out the equipment to pick up and return the equipment!
- \* Equipment may be kept in the County for one week and then returned to the District Office or given to the next County who has reserved it.
- \* County will be responsible for paying a **\$25.00 non-refundable deposit** to use the equipment. Fees generated off of the use of the equipment will be used to replace or repair broken equipment and/or purchase additional resources such as books and new equipment. **Make checks payable to: TCE Account #255310.**
- \* All reservations to use equipment are to be coordinated with Rachel Gonzales, District 4-H Secretary.
- \* The Portable Challenge Equipment Check Out Form must be submitted to request equipment so that we have a list of the equipment needed.
- \* Any equipment/resource books that are damaged or broken should be reported to the District Office so that the equipment can be repaired or removed from the kit until it can be replaced.
