Texas Farm Bureau – Clover Cash Grant Program

Deadline: August 14, 2023

<u>Information:</u> The 2023 Clover Cash Grant program is underway. Applications will close at 11:59 p.m. on **August 14**. As you know, \$20,000 in grant funding is awarded to county, district, and state level 4-H programs. Eligible applicants include AgriLife Extension Agents, District 4-H Specialists, Texas 4-H staff or *adult leaders (*Must provide a letter of support from their County Extension Agent recognizing them as a valid Texas 4-H club) of any county, district, or state level 4-H program. Program information, eligibility requirements and further details can be found <u>HERE</u>.

Project and Application Guidelines:

- Projects should be based on an agricultural concept. Preference will be given to those projects that are handson agricultural learning activities.
- Students must be directly engaged in the educational component.
- A timeline of the project and a list of all community partners must be listed on the application.
- The application must contain a detailed budget with estimated expenses.
- Applications will be accepted from County Extension Agents or Adult Leaders.
- Grant checks will be made payable to an organization, not an individual.

AGENTS ONLY 2022-2023 Texas 4-H Group Enrollment Entry

Deadline for Group Enrollment: September 15, 2023



What is Group Enrollment?

Group Enrollment numbers encompass programs conducted with youth groups such as curriculum enrichment programs within schools and special interest groups conducted in an informal setting. These programs must include at least five sequential learning experiences in one project area and youth participants must have at least two hours of educational instruction.

Reporting Group Enrollment:

Group Enrollment is the annual federal report that combines all Texas 4-H youth programming efforts. This reports any qualifying program targeting youth between September 1 and August 31 each year. Group Enrollment information must be submitted through 4HOnline to be included in each county's ES-237 annual federal youth enrollment report. 4HOnline and the ES237 reports do not pull data from the TAMED system automatically. They are independent of each other and not integrated.

What are "Duplicates"?

Any youth participant who is also 4-H member would be considered a "duplicate" because they are already enrolled through an individual enrollment form in 4HOnline. If a youth program with a series of at least five learning experiences is offered to ONLY 4-H members, it is <u>not</u> included in Group Enrollment. If a youth program with a series of at least five learning experiences is offered to BOTH

4-H members and non 4-H members, then the program may be included in Group Enrollment. The youth participants who were current 4-H members would be considered duplicates.

National Environmental Youth Advisory Council

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) announced the formal establishment of the agency's first-ever National Environmental Youth Advisory Council (NEYAC). The NEYAC will provide independent advice and recommendations to Administrator Michael S. Regan on how to increase EPA's efforts to address a range of environmental issues as they relate to youth communities. The NEYAC will provide a critical perspective on how the impacts of climate change and other environmental harms affect youth communities. EPA is soliciting applications for youth to fill 16 vacancies on the NEYAC. As a first-of-its-kind committee, all members of NEYAC will be between the ages of 16 and 29.
