UPDATES FOR DISTRICT 10 4-H HORSE JUDGING:

NEW for 2024! The District 10 4-H Horse Judging contest will be hosted at the Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo (HLSR) this year. In order to correctly register for this contest, all 4-H members must:

- Submit entries/fees for the Houston Livestock Show & Rodeo via JudgingCard.com. <u>Please contact the</u> <u>local County Office to correctly submit</u> <u>entries by the specified County</u> <u>deadline.</u>
- Register all contestants/teams on 4HOnline by the District February 6th deadline in order compete in the District 10 4-H Horse Judging qualifier.

MEMBERSHIP & AGE DIVISIONS

Participants must be 4-H members currently enrolled on 4HOnline and belong to a Texas 4-H Youth Development County program.

There are three age divisions for competition as outlined below. 4-H members' division is determined by their grade level by Aug. 31, 2023.


- Junior: 3rd (and 8 yrs. old) 5th
- Intermediate: Grades 6th 8th
- Senior: Grades 9th 12th (and passed 18 yrs. old)

Note: Juniors may move up to the Intermediate age division when participating on an intermediate team. Intermediates/Seniors may NOT move up or down to a different age division. Additionally, H.L.S.R. Teams are designated by age. Therefore, their team designations may differ from 4-H. However, District 10 4-H Awards will be based on grade level like any other 4-H contest.

Collegiate Scholarships will NOT be given out in 2024.



- URGENT Information regarding FAFSA & Texas 4-H Foundation Scholarship Applications: FAFSA has rolled out a new form to be used for 2024-2025. FAFSA had a soft launch the last couple of weeks, but it is now fully functioning and the Texas 4-H Foundation will be moving forward with the following updated requirements:
 - Applicants must complete a 2024-2025 FAFSA Application by January 31st to be eligible for consideration for a Texas 4-H Foundation Opportunity Scholarship.
 - In the FAFSA section in the Texas 4-H Foundation Opportunity Scholarship application, applicants will input a "0" for the EFC box.
 - In the FAFSA upload spot, applicants will upload a screenshot of their FAFSA account dashboard that shows their form is in review, submission date, and name of applicant. (Example <u>HERE</u>; You can take this with a phone, snipping tool, print screen, etc. to attach to the application. This screenshot can be from the parent dashboard or the applicant dashboard.)
 - If applicants receive their report back from FAFSA, input the report in the appropriate spots.
 - o If applicants have not received their FAFSA report back by the February 15th deadline, they need to follow the instructions above using their FAFSA submission confirmation.
 - The Texas 4-H Foundation Opportunity Scholarship DEADLINE is still February
 15th. There <u>WILL NOT</u> be an extension on the deadline.
 - Once applicants receive their official FAFSA report back (after February 15th), they will submit it using this link: https://fs23.formsite.com/YVsLnb/junaan8zju/index The deadline to submit your FAFSA report through this link is March 31st.

Other Scholarship Opportunities for 4-H Members:

<u>Texas Farm Bureau Scholarships:</u> Applications for all TFB scholarships are open for submission. TFB awards over \$240,000 each year to graduating high school seniors and enrolled college students. Applications must be submitted by **11:59 p.m. on March 1, 2024**. Winners will be accounted by May 2024. Information on how to apply for the scholarship is available by clicking here.

Big Tex Scholarship Program: Applications for all Big Tex scholarships are open for submission. The Big Tex Scholarship Program has awarded college scholarships to more than 3,000 students for a total of more than \$17.4 million. Eligible recipients include graduating high school seniors around the state of Texas who have participated in competitive youth livestock events held at the State Fair. The application will close on **February 1, 2024**. Information on how to apply for the scholarship is available by clicking here.



<u>Lockheed Martin STEM Scholarship Program:</u> Lockheed Martin will award up to 100 scholarships to those who are selected for the <u>STEM Scholarship Program</u>. CONTEST RULES

- Each 4-H Member may enter up to (3) photos MAXIMUM.
- There are 15 different categories available for submission. Please click the State Photography Rules HERE for category descriptions.
- A 4-H member <u>cannot</u> enter all (3) photos in the same category. The (3) photos must be entered in three different categories.
- If a 4-Her submits more than 3 photos, the registration will be returned and must be corrected by Tuesday - February 27, 2024 in order to be eligible for judging.
- Photos must be taken by the 4-H member between March 1st, 2023 – February 20th, 2024.

As stated in the rules, counties are highly encouraged to have some type of selection process in place to determine which photos are eligible. The timeline for entry is April 1-15. - Qualify from county level (district contests have no bearing on qualifications)
- Open to senior age division only
- 15 categories (includes a new "Abandoned" theme for this year)
