Scholarship Application Deadline: Feb. 15, 2025 @ 11:59PM

FAFSA Application by January 31st.

OVERVIEW:

The Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarships are awarded each year to applicants based on their academic record, 4-H experience, and financial need (for scholarships for which it is a required criterion). The Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarship Program is conducted by the Texas 4-H Youth Development Foundation. Over 200 academically competitive scholarships will be awarded in the 2025 Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarship Program ranging in amounts from \$1,000 to \$30,000. No scholarship recipient whose award is based on this application process will receive less than \$1,000. The Texas 4-H Foundation seeks to ensure that each recipient receives the highest dollar amount of scholarship for which that recipient is eligible. For the majority of the total scholarships and scholarship funds available. participation in a livestock show is not a requirement for consideration.

- A CEA Verification Form will require a CEA signature. The form will need to be signed/uploaded before submitting the application.
- The top-ranking scholars will be invited back for virtual interviews May 2-4 to interview for a \$30,000 scholarship.
- 4-H members are encouraged to complete their FAFSA as soon as it opens on December 1st. Please note, in order to successfully apply for the Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarship, applicants must complete the 2025-2026 FAFSA application no later than January 31st.

Texas 4-H Dog Validation – Deadline Jan. 10, 2025

(2024-2025 Dog Show Rules)

Information: Texas 4-H Dog Show will be held on July 8-10, 2025 at the Hill Country Youth Event Center in Kerrville, Texas. To be eligible for this show, dogs must be validated by January 10, 2025 in 4-H Online. Please **DOWNLOAD** the detailed written instructions on how to validate your dog. Video instructions are here: https://youtu.be/3NzoljK9Pco

We strongly encourage members to validate their dogs even if they are not sure they will be participating in the Texas 4-H Dog Show. Completing the *FREE* validation process before January 10th. As 4-H members complete their validation, here are some things to keep in mind:

- The box that says Breeder is where they list the breed of the dog rather than the breeder.
- For purebred dogs (they do not have to be registered, just look purebred) you will select the correct Group, then type in the breed of the dog.
- For mixed breed dogs you will select the Weight Group of the dog and list the dominant breed along with the word "Mix" or list the two breeds if known. (Example: Border Collie Mix or Mastiff/Great Dane.)
- Photos of the left and right side of the dog should be a side view of the whole dog. Get on the dog's level so they do not turn into top views.
- All photos of your dog should be clear and lit well enough we can see all markings and color of the dog.
- The dog should only be wearing a collar. No sweaters, costumes, rain gear or anything that covers the dog's color and markings.

REMEMBER! Dogs MUST be validated each year. If you validated a dog last year, the information and photos will be in the system, but you must still review and SUBMIT to validate for the 2024-2025 4-H year. Please update the photos if the dog has changed significantly since last year.

We do encourage you to validate any dogs that you are eligible to show. Situations may change throughout the year. Any dogs that need to be substituted for the show will need to be validated.

23-24 IRS Filing Instructions for Texas 4-H Club/Group 990 Forms



THE DEADLINE FOR IRS FILING FOR ALL 4-H CLUBS/GROUPS IS DECEMBER 20, 2024

*If you do not complete this process – your Club EIN is subject to revocation by the IRS.

<u>Information:</u> ALL Texas 4-H, Inc. clubs and groups are required to file their annual information return (Form 990-N, 990 or 990-EZ). <u>The Texas 4-H deadline for clubs filing under Texas 4-H Inc. is **December 20, 2024**. However, **you can file NOW!** Form 990 is the form used by tax-exempt organizations to provide the IRS with the information required on an annual basis. There are several Form 990s that a 4-H club/group can file, depending on their financial status. The Form 990 options are:</u>

- Form 990N (e-postcard): Gross receipts \$50,000 or less.
- Form 990EZ: Gross receipts less than \$200,000 & total assets less than \$500,000 at end of year.
- Form 990: Gross receipts exceeding \$200,000 at the end of the year.

Texas 4-H Foundation Grant Applications OPEN

<u>Information:</u> Texas 4-H Foundation Grant Applications are now open!The purpose of this grant program is to provide funding to County and District 4-H Programming. These funds may be used to enhance (equipment purchases, education/training, events, etc.) existing 4-H programs and projects or to start new 4-H programs or projects.

- The deadline to submit applications is 11:59 pm on December 31st.
- You must submit the application through the online portal.
- The application will ask for a description of how the funds will be used, what problem the funds will be used to address, about your intended audience, for a budget, and how you will evaluate the program.
- You will be notified if you did or did not receive a grant in February 2025.
- If you receive a grant, the funds must be used by August 31, 2026. You must email a one-page summary including 3 pictures to bailee.wright@ag.tamu.edu by August 31, 2026. More information regarding the summary will be sent to those who receive the grant.

- 1. On the site, you will select 4-H or FFA, and select the "tour guide" option. Note: The lunch bunch option is typically filled out by SA Area FCCLA programs – please disregard.
- 2. Tour dates are assigned on a first come, first serve basis
- 3. Be sure to provide us with the number of students you can commit on the days you choose to volunteer
- 4. Students must commit to volunteer from 7:45 am to 2:30 pm on their tour day
- 5. Do not schedule students on the day they sift, classify, or show an animal
- 6. Additional correspondence will be e-mailed after we receive your initial commitment
- 7. Final count and list of student names is due by 5:00 pm on January 10, 2025
- 8. If you have a senior who cannot attend your tour date, we will work with your student's schedule to ensure they are included in all scholarship opportunities
- 9. Remember to make arrangements to have your students excused from school for their tour date(s)
- 10. Registration is handled by the County Agent or Advisor/Sponsor for FFA, 4H and FCCLA
- 11. Parents, **DO NOT** contact School Tours to register your student. See item above to sign up!
- 12. Registration Deadline is December 16, 2024, at 5:00 pm
- 13. Please note, that for your 4-Hers to be eligible for the SALE school tours scholarship (awarded by the Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarship Program), they **MUST** participate as a tour guide and submit a Texas 4-H Opportunity Scholarship application!
